



Free School Meal eligibility is changing

The government are making changes to FSM eligibility as of April, if you qualify by 31st March 2025, your child will retain free school meals for their current phase of education, up to end of Year 6 in primary and if you have any children in secondary up until the end of the secondary school phase too.

The government has extended free school meal eligibility to include some families with no recourse to public funds (NRPF) who receive support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999.
