The trips and activities covered by this consent may include (but are not limited to):

- Visits to local places of interest within the Birtley area
- (e.g., Birtley Library, Birtley Methodist Church, Morrisons, the local post box, local park)
- Attending events or activities at Lord Lawson of Beamish Academy (e.g., sporting or drama events)
- Short walks along nearby streets, including delivering "Acts of Kindness" cards to neighbours
