3. Your Child's Eligibility

Two-year-old funding - where parents meet the eligibility criteria for both the two-year-olds funds, the Early Learning for two-year-olds and the working parent entitlement, local authorities have a duty to account for any hours available under the families receiving the Early Learning fund entitlement when determining how many hours a parent should be funded for under the working parent entitlement. This means that local authorities must fund the first 15 hours under the families receiving additional support before they fund any working parent hours.

If your child is looked after by the local authority, has an education, health and care (EHC) plan, receives Disability Living Allowance (DLA) or has left care under an adoption order, special guardianship order or child arrangements order, they are eligible for Early Learning Funding for two-year-olds. To apply, please show evidence to your childcare provider (such as your child's DLA letter or adoption order).
